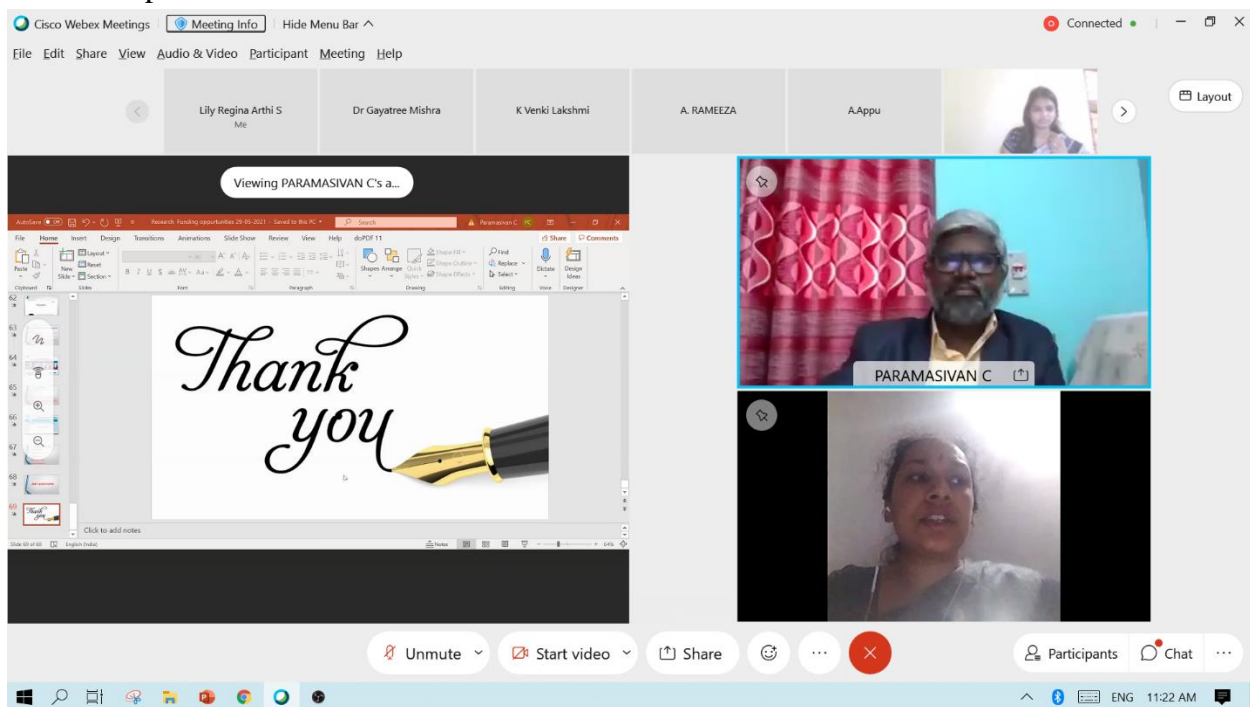

Introduction

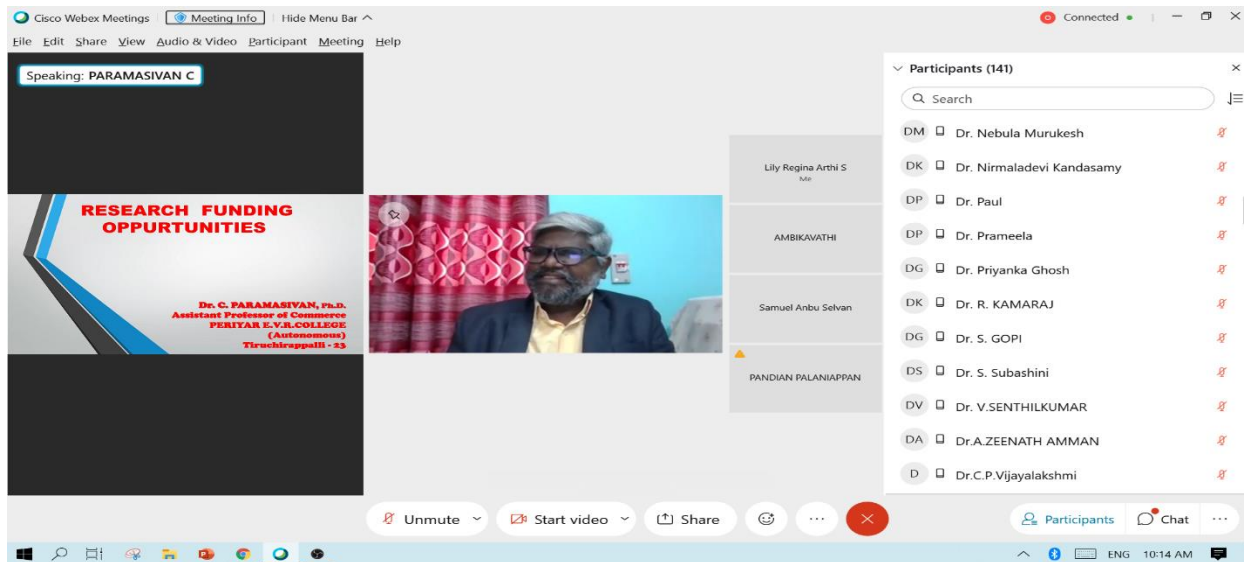

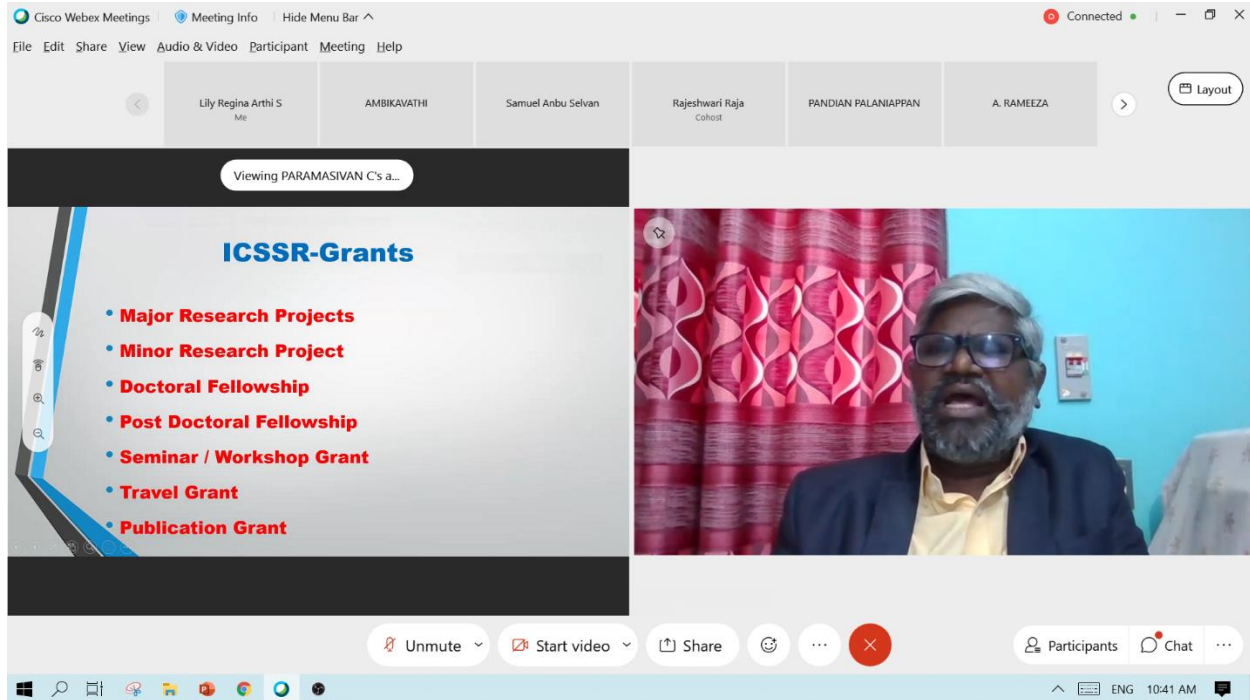
