The Secretary informed the faculty to encourage the students to pay their fees online.

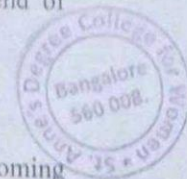
NAAC Schedule

Ms. Vennila, the NAAC Co-ordinator briefed the need for submission of IIQA by March 1st week after which SSR should be uploaded within 45 days. She explained how crucial the number of days are to upload the SSR and therefore to complete the documentation by all the departments. Each question to be answered in the form of data templates, write up and related documents to be filed.

Rev.Sr. Margaret Julie, the secretary of the college suggested all the departments to document the files pertaining to the required data. She also briefed about the hierarchy of arrangement of documents. She also informed the faculty that she can give the college report for 6 years for easy data collection. The Secretary further informed the faculty that the final SSR will be uploaded by 30th April'21 for which the documentation to be completed by the end of March'21.

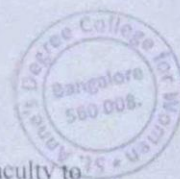

- Think tank cell programs to be conducted shortly for the selected 100 students.

Students and Faculty suggestion




Faculty members suggested that a separate rest room for the differently abled students could be constructed. Also a ramp facility to access the auditorium could be provided.
