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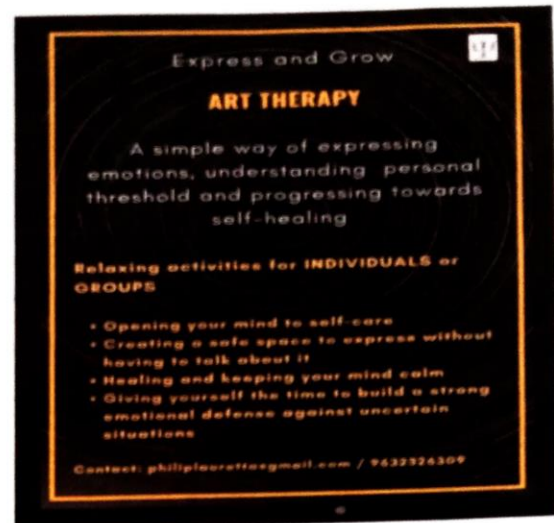
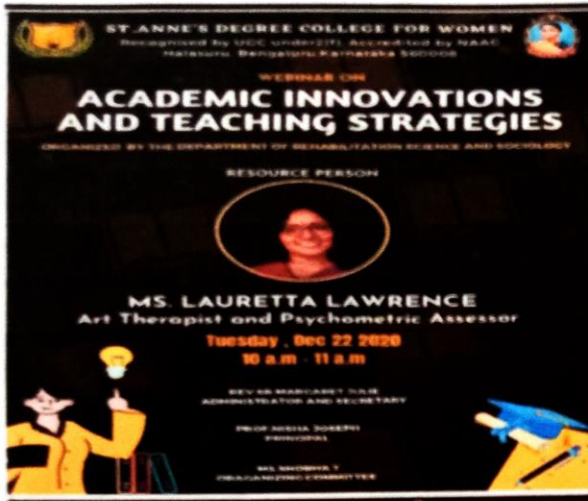
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Report of departmental activities of Bsc Rehabilitation

And the speaker gave an assignment to all the participants at the end of the webinar to mail her a 3 second presentation which contains a powerful message and has visual and audio cues.



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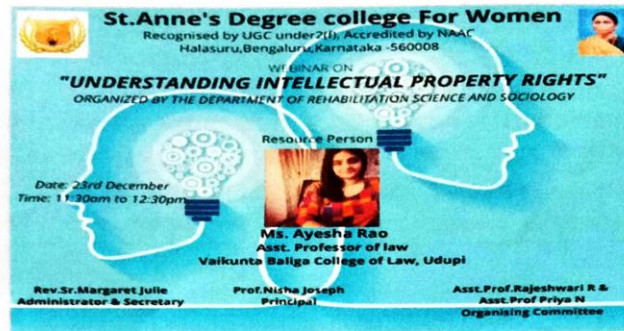


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## INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS
