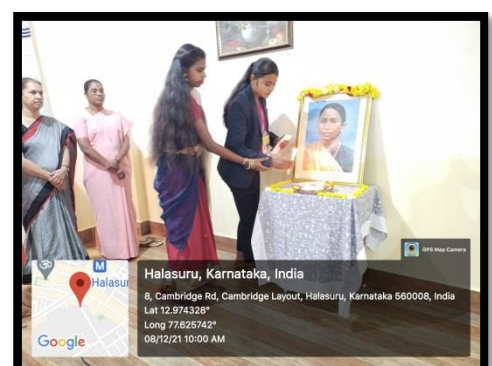
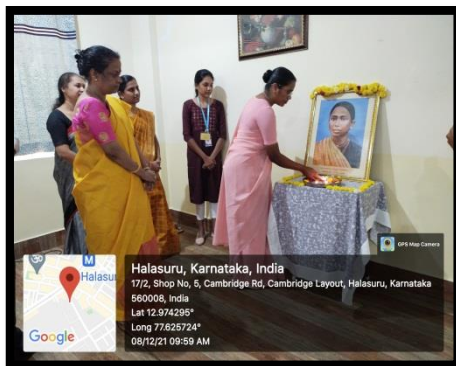

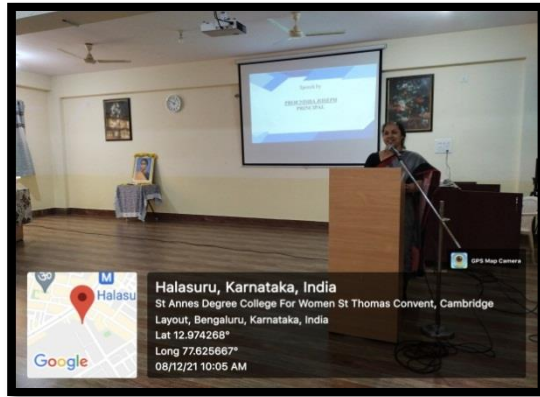
Student Seminar on Social Entrepreneurship – 2021-2022

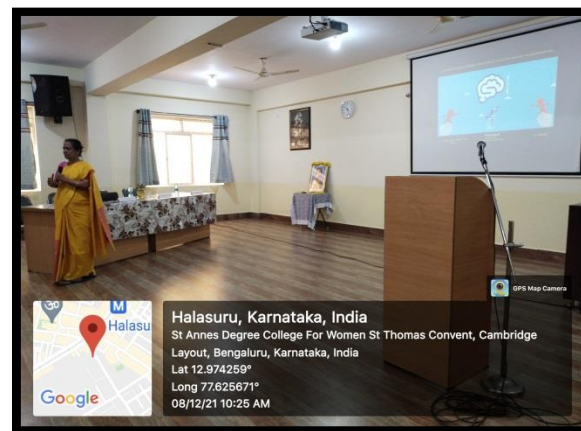
Sr. Prema, Asst. Prof, Department of Business Administration delivered a speech on the qualities required of a successful entrepreneur.
