

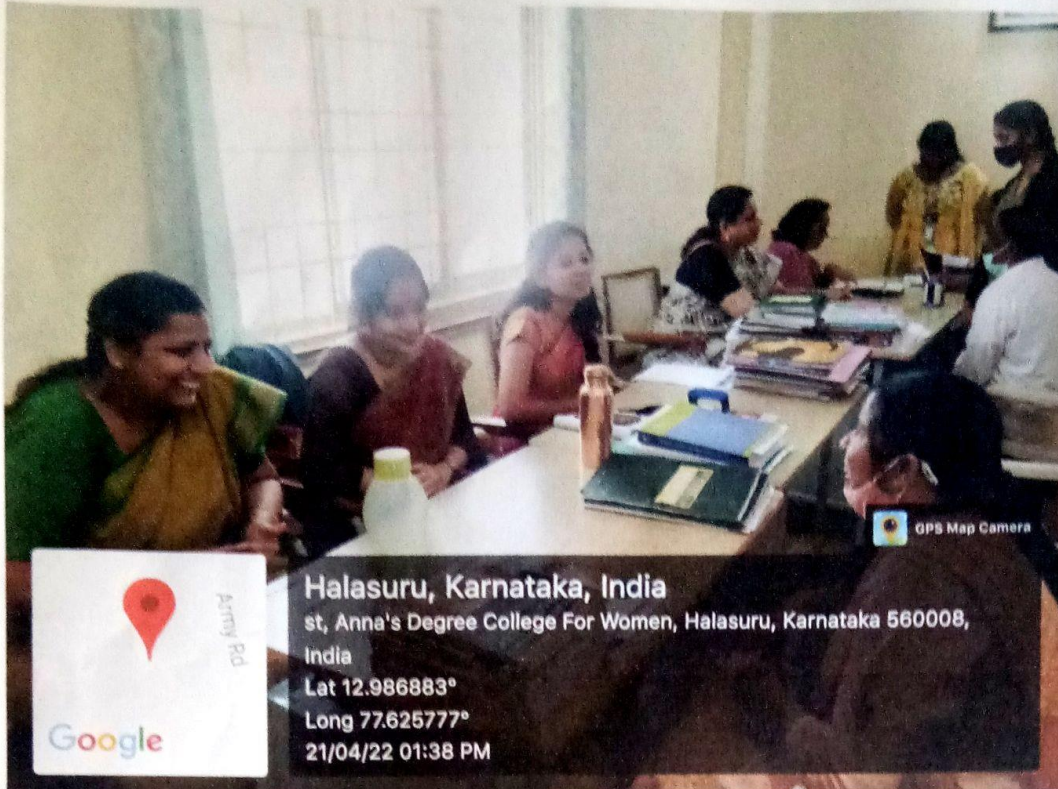

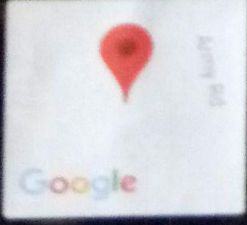

The list of mentees with their respective mentors will be put on the notice board and the same shall be covered to the students in class by their respective class teachers.



On Stress Management

An Online Session conducted by Msc. Psychology Students of Sampurna Montfort College.

Stress

Stress can be defined as any type of change that causes physical, emotional, or psychological strain. Stress is your body's response to anything that requires attention or action. Stress can sometimes be mistaken for anxiety, and experiencing a great deal of stress can contribute to feelings of anxiety. Experiencing anxiety can make it more difficult to cope with stress and may contribute to other health issues, including increased depression, susceptibility to illness, and digestive problems.

Stress and anxiety contribute to nervousness, poor sleep, high blood pressure, muscle tension, and excess worry. In most cases, stress is caused by external events, while anxiety is caused by your internal reaction to stress. Stress may go away once the threat or the situation resolves, whereas anxiety may persist even after the original stressor is gone.

Causes of Stress

Stress can trigger the body's response to a perceived threat or danger, known as the fight-or-flight response. During this reaction, certain hormones like adrenaline and cortisol are released. This speeds the heart rate, slows digestion, shunts blood flow to major muscle groups, and changes various other autonomic nervous functions, giving the body a burst of energy and strength. Stress can also lead to some unhealthy habits that have a negative impact on your health. For example, many people cope with stress by eating too much or by smoking.

Types of Stress

- ✓ **Acute stress:** Acute stress is a very short-term type of stress that can either be positive or more distressing, this is the type of stress we most often encounter in day-to-day life.
- ✓ **Chronic stress:** Chronic stress is stress that seems never-ending and inescapable, like the stress of a bad marriage or an extremely taxing job; chronic stress can also stem from traumatic experiences and childhood trauma.
- ✓ **Episodic acute stress:** Episodic acute stress is acute stress that seems to run rampant and be a way of life, creating a life of ongoing distress.
- ✓ **Eustress:** Eustress is fun and exciting. It's known as a positive type of stress that can keep you energized. It's associated with surges of adrenaline, such as when you are skiing or racing to meet a deadline.

Treatment

Treatment for stress focuses on changing the situation, developing stress coping skills, implementing relaxation techniques, and treating symptoms or conditions that may have been caused by chronic stress. Some interventions that may be helpful include therapy, medication, and complementary and alternative medicine (CAM).

Psychotherapy

Some forms of therapy that may be particularly helpful in addressing symptoms of stress including cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT) and mindfulness-based stress reduction (MBSR). CBT focuses on helping people identify and change negative thinking patterns, while MBSR utilizes meditation and mindfulness to help reduce stress levels.

Medication

Medication may sometimes be prescribed to address some specific symptoms that are related to stress. Such medications may include sleep aids, antacids, antidepressants, and anti-anxiety medications.

Conclusion

Although stress is inevitable, it can be manageable. When you understand the toll it takes on you and the steps to combat stress, you can take charge of your health and reduce the impact stress has on your life.

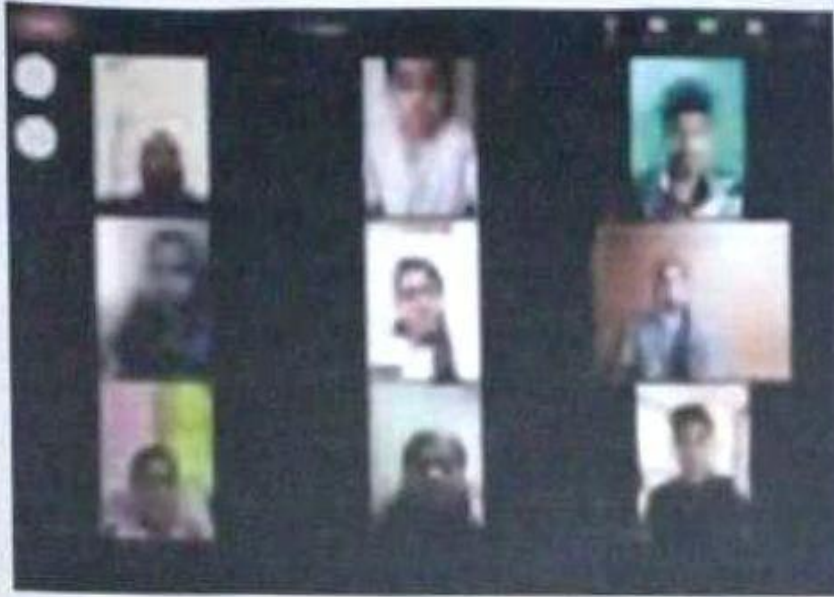
Before you develop an effective time management strategy, you first need to record and analyze how you are currently spending your time each day. Keep track of your daily activities for several days.

On Aggregation and how to control Aggressive Behavior

An Online Session conducted by Msc. Psychology Students of Sampurna Montfort College.

Aggressiveness seems to be a natural part of life that is present in everyone to some degree. There are many different kinds of aggressive behavior and there are theories that highlight its survival value for us as a species. The field of psychology has dedicated a lot of time and work to studying the causes, processes, and consequences of aggressive behavior.

Types of Aggression

There are two types of aggressive behavior: hostile aggression and instrumental aggression. The motive behind the behavior is the primary difference. They have different precedents, they predict different problems, and they are associated with different cognitive and emotional processes.

Different types of aggressive behavior appear to originate in different areas of the brain. The amygdala, the hippocampal formation, the septal area, the prefrontal cortex, and the cingulate cortex seem to modulate aggressive behavior through the connections with the medial and lateral hypothalamus. L. Berkowitz developed the cognitive-neo association theory of aggression based on work by Freud. His theory proposes that being unable to reach the desired goal is what triggers the aggressive impulse. That leads to a negative emotional state, which is the origin of aggressive behavior.

Factors involved in Aggressive Behavior

Among the factors involved in aggressive behaviors are social instigators, non-social factors, and the individual factors of each person. Social instigators include triggers like provocation, the perception of being unjust treatment, or social rejection.

One of the non-social instigators is aggressive keys (images or objects present in the situation that activate aggressive thoughts). For example, the presence of guns or weapons. On the other hand, we have environmental stressors like heat, overcrowding, and loud noises act like triggers to aggressive behavior. There are also cognitive factors involved. These would be rumination, moral disconnection, or the activation of scripts (outlines that represent situations that guide aggressive behavior).

So, these scripts store the memory of experiences and situations that you can easily remember. You might also store up beliefs about how normal behavior should be in certain circumstances.

Signs of Aggression

- ✓ Physical, like beating, hitting, kicking, or stabbing another person. Damaging property is also a form of physical aggression.
- ✓ Verbal, which may include mocking, name-calling, and yelling.
- ✓ Relational, which is intended to harm another person's relationships. This can include spreading rumors and telling lies about someone else.
- ✓ Passive-aggressive, like ignoring someone during a social event or offering back-handed compliments. Passive-aggressive behavior is usually intended to allow harm to come to someone, rather than causing harm directly.

Psychological Factors of Aggression

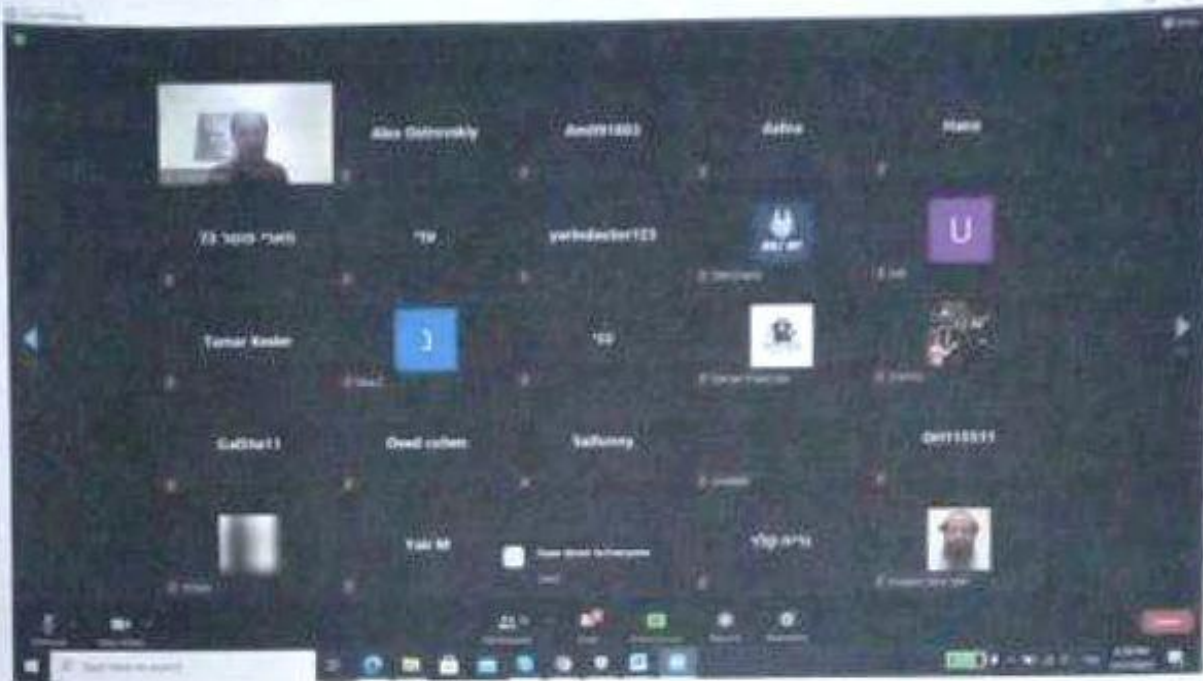
Several mental health conditions can be associated with aggressive behavior, including:

- ✓ Attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD)
- ✓ Bipolar disorder⁶
- ✓ Borderline personality disorder (BPD)
- ✓ Narcissism⁸
- ✓ Post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD)
- ✓ Epilepsy, dementia, psychosis, substance use disorder, and brain injuries or abnormalities can also influence aggression.

Managing Aggression

- ✓ Being mindful of your anger warning signs, like clenching your jaw, a fast pulse, or sweating
- ✓ Practicing relaxation techniques like deep breathing, meditation, or progressive muscle relaxation (PMR)
- ✓ Engaging with your senses by focusing on things you can see, smell, hear, touch, or taste
- ✓ Walking away from the situation
- ✓ Exercising to burn off excess energy
- ✓ Reaching out to a trusted friend or family member for social support
- ✓ Distracting yourself with another activity

- ✓ Reframing negative thoughts
- ✓ Learning to explore and accept the emotions underlying the aggression.



Conclusion

Aggression is often the byproduct of another underlying factor. Exploring and addressing that root cause can often help reduce aggressive behavior.

On Ragging and how to overcome the problem of ragging

An Online Session conducted by MSc. Psychology Students of Sampurna Montfort College.

Ragging may have started out as a harmless way for senior students to get to know their new juniors especially in residential institutions like Colleges of Engineering, Medicine or Law. However, it has developed into a far more concerning issue. More severe forms of ragging could include bullying, abuse, whether physical, sexual or emotional, exploitation, etc. Ragging is any disorderly conduct that has the effect of teasing or handling with rudeness any student, which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, harm or to raise fear in a junior so as to adversely affect the psyche of the junior. In the beginning, ragging was an amusing practice. It has degenerated into an evil. It has become a synonym for torture'. The Supreme Court of written or by an act which adversely affects the physique or physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student is an act of ragging. But if through ragging the decency and morals are violated or one's body gets injured or if any wrongful restraint or criminal intimidation is involved in it, then ragging becomes a legal offence.

Ragging can take a number of forms. For example, the 2000 report of UGC includes some of the following forms.

- ✓ To ask/answer vulgar questions,
- ✓ To look at pornographic pictures
- ✓ To shock the fresher out of their innocence';
- ✓ To force to drink alcohol, scalding tea, etc.,
- ✓ To force to do acts with sexual overtones, including homosexual acts;
- ✓ To force to do acts which can lead to physical injury/mental torture or death,
- ✓ To strip, kiss, etc.;
- ✓ To do other obscenities.

Psychology behind ragging

Effort-Justification:

The idea is that we value things more when we gain it by overcoming difficulties (Aronson and Mills, 1958). If a fresher feels that he dedicated a lot of time and furnished serious effort in order to obtain his membership, it is logical he tends to value it more.

Stockholm syndrome:

August 1973, two bank robbers, in Stockholm held 3 women and a man hostage for a period of 6 days. In those six days the hostages developed emotional bonds with their captors and exhibited shocking attitude. They not only resisted the attempt made by the police to rescue them but one of the woman hostages later got engaged to one of the kidnappers. Psychologists later tried to study the behavior shown by the Stockholm hostages and termed this phenomenon as 'Stockholm Syndrome'. Psychologists believe that ragging is one example of 'Social Stockholm Syndrome'. In ragging behavior, it is frequently seen that at first the victims are tortured and then they are behaved to in a good way. Such psychological technique even breaks the person psychologically (Harsh Agarwal, 2010).

Consequences of Ragging

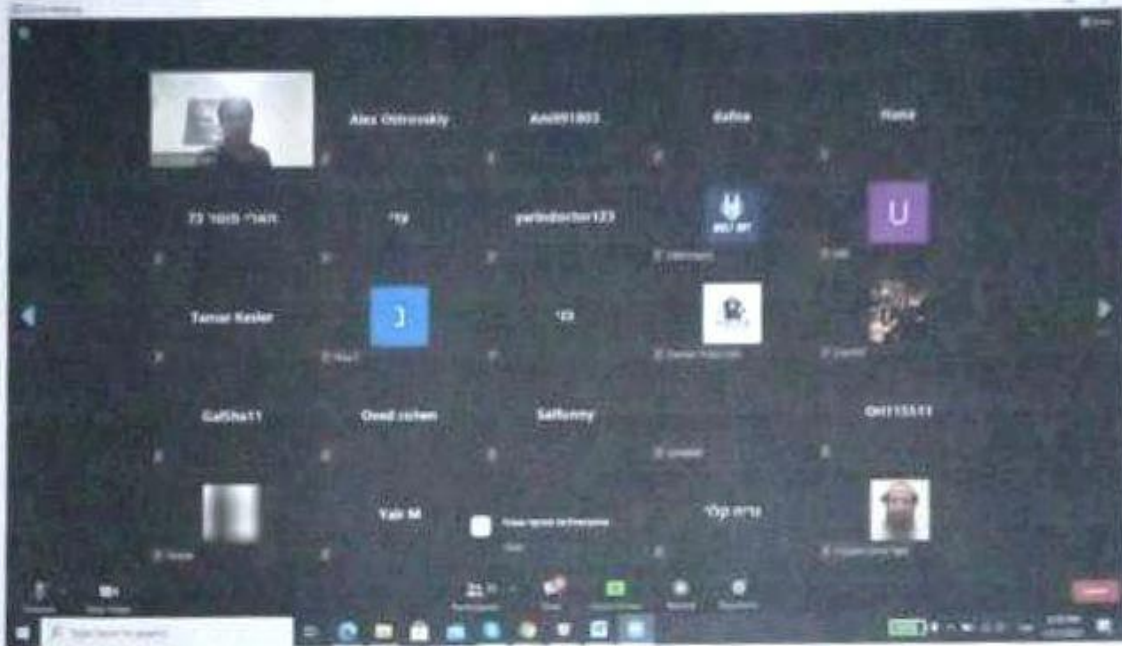
When you come to your institute with a bunch of aspirations to achieve, to have new friends, to learn and innovate and you end up in a hostel room being beaten by your seniors. It is likely that you will develop fear and an immense helplessness. Sometimes while ragging, seniors make fun of one's name, one's birthplace or one's dressing. The confidence of the young mind is broken. He may end up being dissatisfied with something which he can't change. Traumatic experiences are also not very rare. Sometimes the traumatic experience of torture, humiliation, and insult may lead to permanent damage in one's psyche. There are some students who may actually leave the institution due to such negative experience at the beginning of it. Serious psychological problem like Depression is also found among ragging victims. Incidents of suicides and suicide attempts are also reported. The effects of ragging extend beyond the victim. The family members, who may have arranged for resources for the education of their children with all difficulties, also feel helpless. Sometimes, the fear of hurting parents makes the victims suppress the intense problems that they are facing. That is even more detrimental to mental health.

- Can result in physical injury due to beating, hitting with the help of objects, or due to tasks performed against a person's will.
- Psychological fear due to intense fear.
- It is an abuse of human rights.
- Can lead to forceful initiation on alcohol and drugs.
- Sometimes, people are so affected by ragging, that they tend to drop out of college.
- It leads to mob mentality and mindset.
- Can also result in deaths.

Why is ragging not being controlled?

- ✓ The fear of being more tortured and more victimized causes silence from the victim's side.
- ✓ The victims fear that the authority will force them to withdraw complains.

- ✓ In most institutes, the authority figures lack the moral responsibility in being strict to deal with the problem of ragging. They don't consider the negative consequences of ragging and continue to accept it as a ritual for years to come.
- ✓ Fear that they and/or their family members will be harassed and victimized
- ✓ They don't want to ruin the careers of the "raggers".



Conclusion

There are a number of factors and its related encouraging factors which give birth to such ghastly acts.

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WORKSHOP ON HEALTH AND HAPPINESS

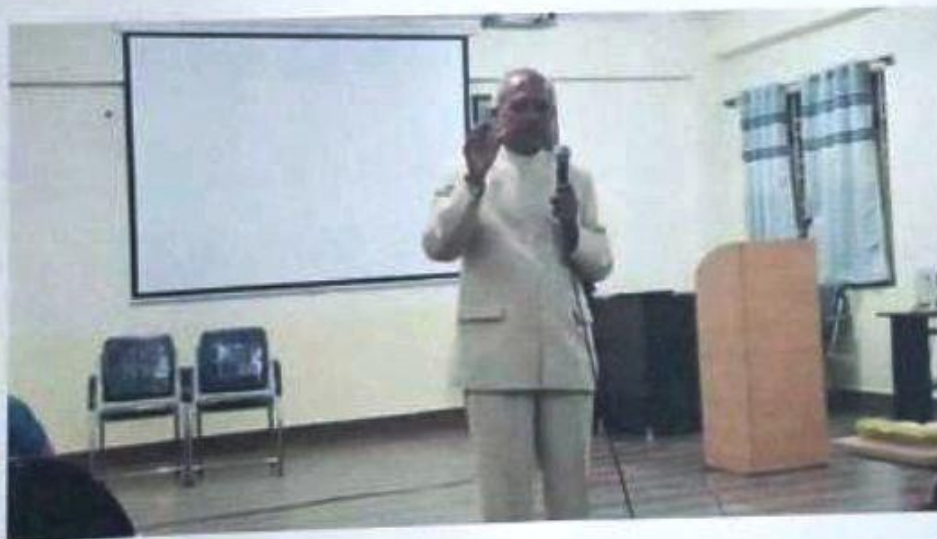
27th NOVEMBER 2021

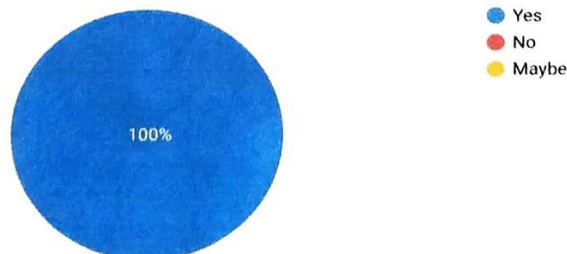
