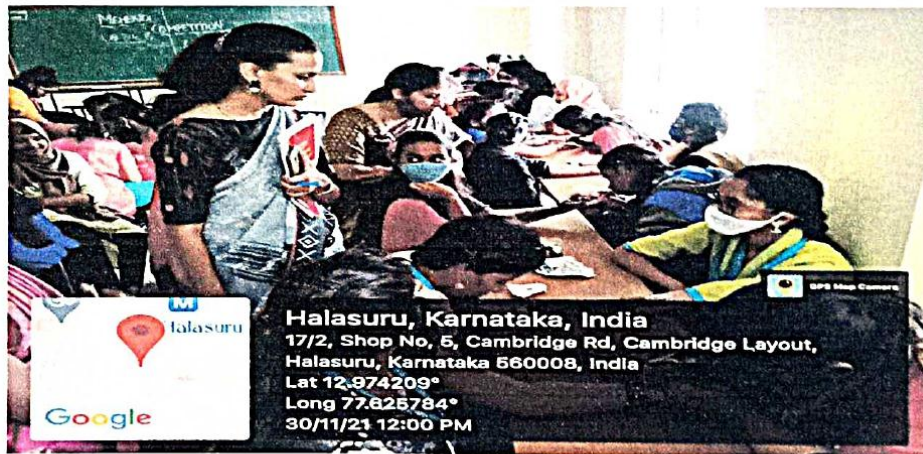

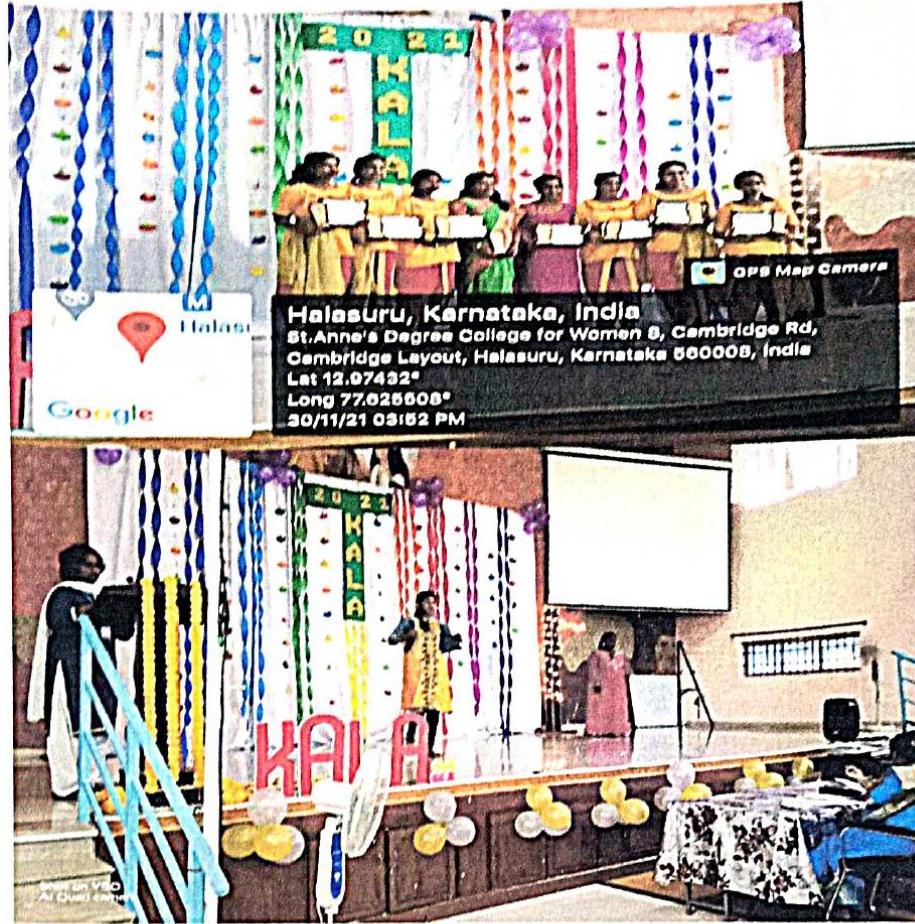

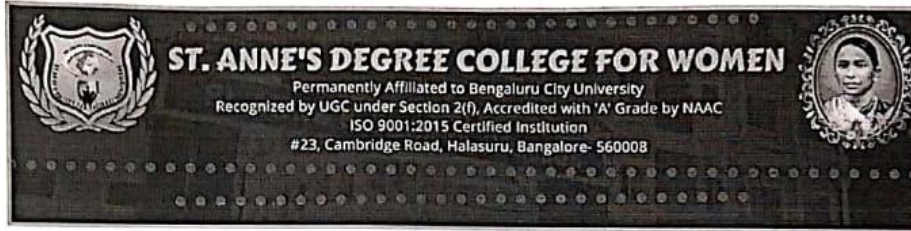

Eco Blitz 2022 Ms. Alen Krithika and Ms. Daljith was the Host for the Event and gave graceful introduction to the Theme.

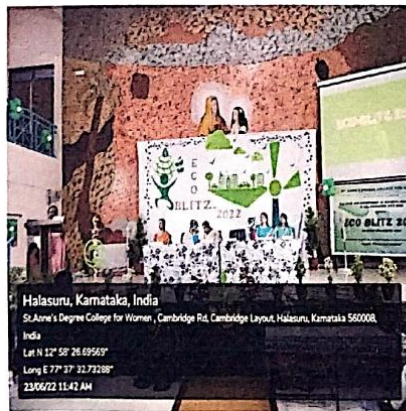


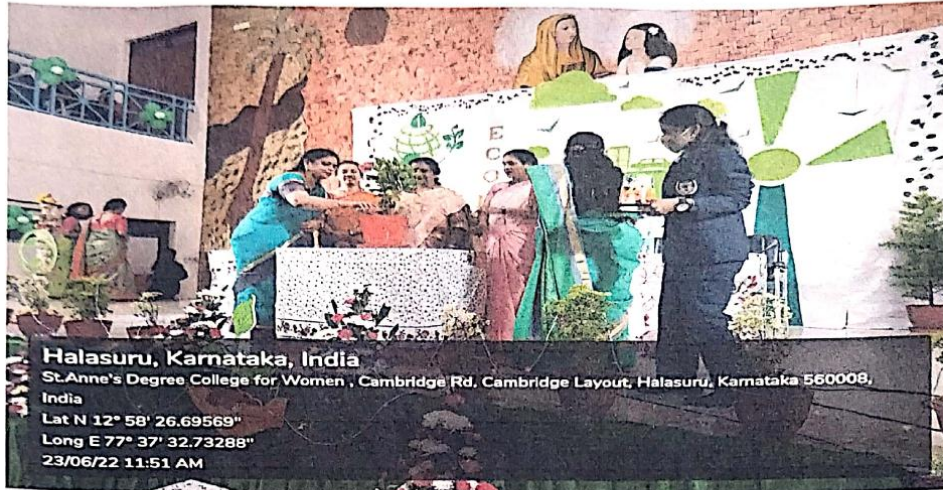

## NSS SPECIAL CAMP - 2021-22

NSS special camp 2021-22 was proposed with the co-ordination of NSS program officer Dr. R. Ramesh Naik and co- program officer Dr. H. Ravi, Mr. Krishna, Ms. Shobha, Ms. Priya and Ms. Navya to Dr. Govinda Gowda NSS coordinator, Bengaluru City University. The date and place of the camp was finalized under the guidance of Rev. Sr. Dr. Margaret Fatima Mary, Secretary of our college.

CAMP DATE: 7th June 2022 to 13th June 2022

PLACE: Pavagada, Tumkur District

The circular was sent to all the NSS volunteers to enroll for NSS camp. Nearly 51 students enrolled themselves. The NSS volunteers were asked to get a concern cum permission letter from their parents to stay in the camp for a week. The preparation for the camp was started before one week. Necessary tools, first aid box and T-shirts for students were taken. The camp activities was scheduled every afternoon, lecture on specific topics like first aid practices, value and moral education.

On the day of special camp, 7<sup>th</sup> June 2022 at 7:00 AM the students left the college with the NSS program officer, Dr. R. Ramesh Naik with Principal Prof. Nisha Joseph and camp advisor Rev. Sr. Dr. Margaret Fatima Mary, Secretary.

The lunch was arranged for all the NSS volunteers in the school. The inauguration of NSS camp scheduled around 4:00 PM and the Chief Guest for the day was Sri. Ashwath Narayanan .N, BEO, Pavagada and Rev. Sr. Dr. Margaret Fatima Mary and the guest of honor was Prof. Nisha Joseph, principal; Sr. Prema Assistant Professor, St. Anne's Degree College for Women Sr. Rosali , the Head Mistress of St. Xavier Primary School, Pavagada, Sr. Gayanam and Sr. Lilly staff teacher; NSS officer Dr. R. Ramesh Naik and other staffs were present.

### PROGRAM

The inauguration of the special camp had begun with a prayer song, a welcome dance, followed by flag hoisting and NSS song. The chief guest Sri. Ashwath Narayanan addressed the gathering followed by, our principal, Prof. Nisha Joseph also addressed the NSS volunteers about the importance and necessity of NSS unit and service needed to the society. 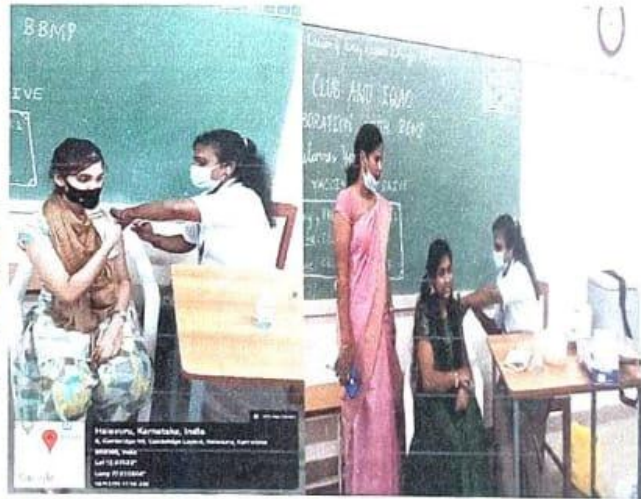




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## 2.National Pulse Polio Programme 27.02.2022 to 02.03.2022 52 students
