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## Best practice I

### 1. Title of the Practice: *Mother Gnanamma Fund – 'A Rupee A Day'*

### 2. Objectives of the Practice

Mother Gnanamma Fund – A Day A Rupee scheme was formulated to provide the financial support for the needy and help them to fulfill their basic need for their day-to-day life. The scheme is 'committed to change lives'. The main objective of the scheme is to help the truly needy people who find it difficult to meet their basic requirements for their life.

### 3. The Context

The Mother Gnanamma Fund initiative has been conceptualized to provide financial support to poor and needy. The scheme aims to reach various causes of community in order to improve the society. In the academic year 2022-23, Mother Gnanamma fund was utilized for distribution of new clothes and stationeries for tribal school children of Annai Teresa Primary School, Kalakambadi, Salem District, Tamil Nadu. The sisters of society of St. Anne have identified the children who were really in need and presented them with clothes and other items.

### 4. The Practice

The scheme was designed to raise a specific amount of money to meet the cause. The college has taken initiative to impart the value among students to be more philanthropic by introducing "A rupee a day scheme". Every class is provided with a donation box for the students to drop a rupee a day. Student volunteers under the guidance of class teachers collected one rupee from every student on daily basis. Apart from this faculty members, Principal and college management also contribute certain amount towards the fund for each semester. The fund collected will be utilized for the people who are in need.





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### 5. Evidence of Success

Rev. Sr. Joyce, Provincial, Rev. Sr. Dr. Margaret Fatima Mary, Prof. Nish Joseph, Principal, Sr. Imelda Rani, Sr. Prema and Dr. Puttanna had joined hands in successfully collecting the amount. A total sum of rupees 60,000/- was collected. In the presence of school management we presented the children with new clothes. The scheme has helped 'ninety-nine' children from Annai Teresa Primary School of which fifty-two were boys and forty-seven were girls. Since it is not possible for every individual to support the needy, this initiative of joining hands together by contributing a very small amount was a great victory. Every benefactor had a pleased feel that even their small contribution has helped to serve for the society.

### 6. Problems Encountered and Resources required

The scheme required only the generous hearts to raise funds and not any physical properties or requirements to attain the objective. It was challenging to motivate the students to contribute to the scheme (A rupee a day). We had to really work and visit home to home to find the beneficiary of the scheme. Another major problem was that, we had to get permission from the local heads, Gram Panchayat and also meet the local people in identifying the real needy people who was in sought of help.

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### Best Practice II

1) **Title of the Practice** –Computer Literacy Workshop for school children.

2) **Goal** - The only way to adequately prepare children for the future is through computer education classes that teach students about computers and technology. Preparing students for the workforce is one goal of education today. Since almost all jobs now and in the future will require students to use technology in some form; students need to begin learning the basics of how computers work and how technology enhances life. We want to achieve our goal of “SKILL DEVELOPMENT & COMPUTER LITERACY” program through “FREE COMPUTER EDUCATION” in schools.


3) **The Context**- The students of **BBMP Government School, Jogupalaya** learnt the basic computer fundamental skills which included Tux Paint, MS Photo Editor, GIF Animations, MS-office, MS-PPT.

4) **The practice**- The Department of Computer Application continued its Outreach Programme with “**BBMP Government School, Jogupalaya**”. The Memorandum of understanding MOU was signed between schools and our college. The syllabus on basics computer was framed and the Outreach Programme started from 16<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> November 2022. Four Students from II year BCA selected to conduct the Outreach Programme for two hours a day. This Outreach Programme helped the young children to learn the fundamentals of computer and MS Office Application.

5) **Evidence of Success**- It was a successful workshop. The students were happy. The school management has appreciated our college student's work. The syllabus was completed on time. Oral assessment was done to test the outcome of the workshop which came out to be positive. The school's management is inviting us for continuing “Computer Literacy Programme” for every year.


6) **Problems encountered and resources required**-

- Obsolete computers –The computers were very old and were not working properly.
