MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MoU") is entered into on **10.10.2022** by and between **LET US DREAM**, a Public Charitable Trust (hereinafter referred to as "First Party" which expression, unless excluded by or be repugnant to the subject or context thereof, shall be deemed to include its successors-in-office, administrators and permitted assigns) having its (Let Us Dream Trust, DRC Post, Bangalore, Karnataka) is a Public Charitable Trust (173/18)

AND

St. Anne's Degree College for Women, No 23, Cambridge Road, Halasuru, Bangalore-560008, hereinafter referred to as "Second Party" which expression, unless excluded by or be repugnant to the subject or context thereof, shall be deemed to include its successors-in-office, administrators and permitted assigns), represented by Dr Sr Margaret Fatima, Secretary as SECOND PARTY.

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

WHEREAS

- A) The First Party – (Let Us Dream Trust, DRC Post, Bangalore, Karnataka) is a Public Charitable Trust (173/18)
- B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- C) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within the areas of organizing Community Conferences, Community Service-learning projects, Psychosocial skills development programs, which will benefit students and also the community at large.
- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.
- E) **St. Anne's Degree College for Women, No 23, Cambridge Road, Halasuru, Bangalore-560008**, the Second Party is an academic organization with higher education institution run by the Society of Sisters of St Anne- Madras

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Institution** and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of

shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1 The second party will host the Let us Dream Annual Conference in Bangalore, Karnataka, with adequate support and involvement from the first party. The date of the Annual Conference to be mutually agreed.
- 2.2 The second party will provide the necessary infrastructure, equipment and resources for conducting the Annual Conference
- 2.3 The first party will provide the necessary know-how, expertise, the needed resources and the needed support in conducting the Annual Conference
- 2.4 Any other program organized jointly can be planned and executed on mutually agreed terms, including exploring the possibility of future joint research possibilities.

CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 3.1 Training materials provided / developed specifically for this particular Community Conference is the intellectual property the First Party and can be used by the Second Party.

CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid for 1 year from the date of Signing the MOU
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved in the agreement of discussion between both parties. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Karnataka

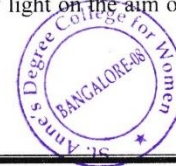

The college is accredited by NAAC with 'A' grade and has received various Academic excellence awards and ISO certified. The College for the first time has collaborated with the "LET US DREAM" foundation to bring about the knowledge from research scholars, academicians, industrialists and practitioners to synergize improvements on community initiatives.

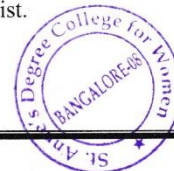

- I. **Education Panel** Comprising of Ms. Lisa Jungkamp – A german social worker and systemis counselor, Ms. Priya Krishnamurthy – Co-founder and CEO of Children's Movement, Ms. Sidra Siddiqua – an Aspiring Psychologist and a social worker, Mr. Yogesh – A, Christite (MBA) and is associated with KPMG global service and the Moderator – Dr. Anne Varghese is a speech and hearing specialist.





The Panel discussed about the challenges faced by students and individuals to empower communities and to create sustainable communities. Few Innovative strategies to instill leadership skills amongst students were discussed. The Resources to overcome challenges of sustainable communities are willingness to learn and change, socializing, mental health stability, networking and active participation.

The Panel answered few questions about students understanding about sustainability Development and Sustainability development transfer to education, ways to design sustainability development and who is your community. The Panel even explained about dreams to create through community.

➤ Madhusudhan Shukla - Education

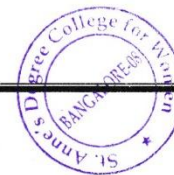

Through the kalinga foundation, he has empowered children in to be eco ambassadors. He interacts with teachers and urban population too on environment conservation. His efforts are transforming the future Indian citizens to be sensitized about sustainable environment.

➤ Gousiya Sultana-Health

Ms. Gousiya works as the Anganwadi worker under the integrated child development services, Government of India, Neelasandra, Bangalore. She takes care of around 50 children and uses innovative techniques such as Whatsapp audio messages and video display in her Anganwadi to convey health and education related information to parents and children. Her work is impactful for children of India who are from underprivileged, minority and migrant background to attain holistic development.

GOUSIYA SULTANA is undoubtedly one of many generous and kind and selfless women who strives for the betterment of children education and gives a lot of importance to education. She



includes self-defense and more. Initially, she started the Anganwadi with 3 – 6 children with less amount of money in her hand, now she has an organization and gives education to many children. Her kind attitude of providing the basic need to the one who lack in it, and with the only intention of doing good to the needful for their future betterment is what inspires others.

GOUSIYA SULTANA strongly believes that when we give 100% of the work, the nature somehow returns it.

➤ **Indumathi - Social**

Ms. Indumathi is a former waste picker who worked in dry waste collection centre. Now she is an entrepreneur managing dry waste collection in 3 wards of Bangalore. She creates awareness about waste segregation and maintain liaison with residents. Through partnership with the BBMP, she manages to remove 3500KG of dry waste per day. She has created employment for 88 individuals, providing benefits such as free breakfast, lunch and tuition services for their dependents. Through her efforts, Bangalore is a cleaner and a better place and waste management has become a more dignified occupation.

It takes absolute Strength and courage to make INDUMATHI what she is today. She is a former waste picker but was never ashamed of what she does. She always wanted to do something more to change the lives of the dry waste collector and that hunger never kept her away from striving hard and that result in what she is today; today she provides employment to 88 others. She creates awareness about waste segregation and with the partnership with BBMP she manages to eliminate 3500 KG of dry waste daily that makes significant difference and a better place to live health.

DR.GEETHA RAMANUJAM – Founder and Academic Director, GR Educational Institutions

Dr. Geetha Ramanujam is a powerful public speaker and promoter of spiritual counseling. Her service to education by establishing an Educational Institution on Guru Kula Philosophy is highly noted. She emboldens the confident and encouragement to do social works in the audience. Her main motive was to educate girls especially in rural areas which is seen till today and works for eradicating it. She gave an enliven example of women empowerment and women education on sulekere in Nagamangala and further narrated, The story goes that the woman was courtesan with the local chieftain who lived in that village and when the village faced a lot of water scarcity, its widely believed that she sacrificed herself for the lake just because no other person in the village have thirst to have water. Dr. Geetha believes that this is what defines selflessness and encouraged us to be challenging, to face conflicts, to have controversy and yet to stay firm.

Dr. Geetha Ramanujan quotes the great old saying of A.P.J. Abdul Kalam: “The dream you dream shouldn't let you sleep until it's fulfilled”.
