Counseling cell orientation on Stress Management was conducted.

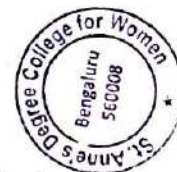
Further the Secretary suggested to bring awareness for students on various irrelevant apps.

- Timings from 10<sup>th</sup> Aug '23 onwards 1 from 12pm to 4pm for faculty and 1pm-4pm for students.

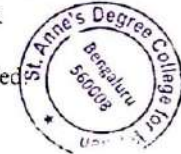
The Secretary further suggested to work as one family towards the vertical growth of the institution. The meeting came to an end and the Principal thanked all.
