- 3. The Content:** The Mother Gnanamma Fund initiative has been conceptualized to provide financial support to poor and needy. The good practice aims to reach various causes of community in order to serve the society and to change the youth’s mindset. In the academic year 2023-24 (**24th July 2024**), Mother Gnanamma Fund was utilized for distribution of clothes, ration bags, cakes & biscuit’s and few bags of toiletries and laundry items for boys and men’s (mentally and physically challenged) of morning stars ashram, (morning stars learning center) sy. no. 146/3, chagalatti village, bagaluru post, bengaluru north 562149, phone number 9900071992 on 24th July 2024. The sisters of society of St. Anne have identified the boys who ignored by own parents and by government and were really in need of Mentally, Physically and financially some maintenance or funding.
- 4. The Practice:** The scheme was designed to raise a specific amount of money to meet the cause. The college has taken initiative to impart the value among students to be more humanitarian by introducing “A Day a rupee practice”. Every class is provided with a donation box for the students to contribute a rupee a day. Student volunteers under the guidance of class teachers and the cell Coordinator Dr. H. R.
