➤ **24<sup>th</sup> September 2021 – Faculty Orientation Programme**

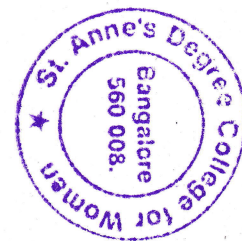

➤ **15<sup>th</sup> February 2022 – Guest Lecture on “ Gender Discrimination in Indian Society”**

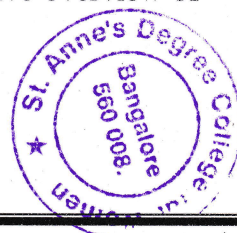

➤ **07<sup>th</sup> July 2022 – National Conference on “Emerging Trends in Research: Sustainable Development Perspectives”**

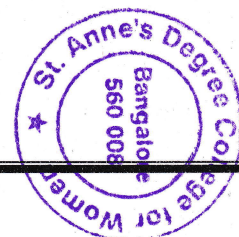
