## Admission Procedure

The application form duly filled must be submitted at the College Office within the stipulated date. A list of provisionally selected applicants will be displayed on the College Notice Board and College Website. This is not an admission list nor does it entitle one to admission. Provisionally selected students shall present themselves for Interview along with their Parents. Admissions are made by the Principal and the Admission Committee, after the Personal Interview.

## Note for Admitted Students

- Selected Candidates will be admitted in the order in which they pay their fees.
- Those who do not pay their fees within the stipulated time will be assumed to have cancelled the admission.
- Fees once paid will not be refunded.
- Original Certificates submitted at the time of the admission will be returned only after the completion of Admission approval by the University.
- Admission obtained by false representation will be cancelled with the forfeiture of fees.
- All admissions are provisional until they are approved by the University.

## Rules and Regulations

The Institution strongly believes in creating a just society through right education to the students. Keeping in view the betterment of the students, the management expects certain disciplinary practices from the students.

### **Punctuality**

The college appreciates and acknowledges the students' punctuality and discipline. The Students who come late will obtain the signature of the faculty incharge or Security on a late coming attendance record sheet of the Handbook at the gate.

### **Personal Discipline**

Regularity, Obedience, Courtesy in Speech and Conduct, respect for elders, cleanliness in dress and person is expected from every student. Irregular attendance, disobedience and objectionable conduct will justify dismissal.

### **Campus Discipline**

Outsiders other than the parents are not permitted to enter the campus. Stringent action will be initiated on those who bring outsiders to the campus.

### **Ragging**

Ragging is a criminal offense against the Law. College would not encourage such activities in the campus; any issues related to this can be addressed to the college authorities. If any such crime found, the student would be called for action i.e Cancellation of Admission, Suspension from the college and punishment.



## **ID Card**

The student shall carry her ID card every day to the college and shall produce it at the gate and when required.

## **Mobile Phones**

The mobile phones are strictly prohibited in the classroom and in the college premises. If any student is found using the mobile phone, it would be confiscated. If there is an emergency the students can use the college phone available in the office.

## **Safety**

The student is required to submit six pass port size photographs and a family photograph at the time of admission. This would ensure the safety of the student at any strange situation.

## **Dress Code**

Students are expected to wear simple and modest clothes and they are permitted to wear Chudithar with Dupattas pinned or Jeans with long closed tops.

# **Parent Involvement**

St.Anne's believes in participatory management and collaborative execution of its policies. It considers parents as its main contributors in maintaining discipline and orderliness. It expects support in the areas of academic progression, overall development of their ward, cooperation towards Co-curricular & Extra-curricular activities to benefit the students.




# Training and Placement
